DESCRIPTION OF THE INSTALATIONS

The City of Cádiz Sports Centre is divided into several sports zones:

A.- SWIMMING-POOLS ZONE:

In an area of 3.600 m² there is three heated indoor swimming-pools with a total water surface of 1.645, 5 m².

These swimming-pools are up to date with all the official regulations according to the Installations Homologations, to celebrate official competitions for Swimming, Water polo and Synchronized Swimming.

DIMENSIONS:

1.- Competition Swimming-pool:

Vessel of 50 x 25 metres, with a variable depth of 2,10 to 3 metres and a total water volume of 3.000 m³ and a water surface of 1.250 m².

2.- Warm up and training swimming-pool:

Vessel of 25 x 12,50 metres, with a maximum depth in the centre of 1,40 metres, and a total volume of water of 400 m³ and a water surface of 312,5 m².

3.- Children's swimming-pool:

Circular vessel of 10.30 metres of diameter, with an average depth of 0,65 metres, and a total water volume of 60 m³ and a water surface of 83 m².

TECHNICAL FILE

The swimming pools are provided with:

- Two general changing rooms with capacity for 50 people.
- Four individual changing rooms with lockers and cabins, with a total capacity of 300 people.
- One changing room for disable people.
- Infirmary
- Toilets for swimmers, babies and disable people available by the swimming-pool beaches.
- Rooms for coaches, monitors and officials.
- Lighting system that permits to transmit colour TV.
- Sound system in all the swimming-pool areas, as well as the specific audition underwater for Synchronized swimming.
- Fixed public seating area with capacity for 1.400 people.

B.- ANEXED ZONES

1.- PAVILION ZONE & SQUASH:

Race track of 49 x 35 metres and a free height of 10 metres. Wooden floor with a double trailing, very well adapted, which will be use as a relax zone for the competitors.

The Pavilion has:

- 6 changing rooms for competitors with capacity for 15 people each.
- Changing room for Officials and Coaches.
- First aid room.
- Stock rooms.
- Fixed public seating area for 900 people.

2.- GYMNASIUM:

Room of 26 x 14 metres and height of 10 metres, with wooden floor and double trailing and transparent ceiling, which provides it with a natural lighting.

It also has two changing rooms with individual lockers which are use by the people using this installation and also by the people using the body building room.



This room will be accommodated as a reward and accreditation room.

3.- BODY BUILDING ROOM:

This installation has two rooms:

The body building room with 20 x 13 metres, equipped with all the necessary elements to perform the body building exercises.

Room for aerobics of 12 x 20 metres, equipped with cardio and fitness.

4.- SAUNA:

Finish Sauna with capacity for 4 persons, made with first class quality wood, illuminated inside, with temperature regulation and all the accessories for a complete sauna bath.

5.-MEETING ROOM:

The Centre has two Meeting Rooms, one with 10 x 16 metres with capacity for 60 people and another one with 8 x 11 metres with capacity for 30 people, they will be accommodated for LEN and the Organization offices.
